Byelaw (6) Zones

Zones

1. There shall be Zones established to discuss issues and recommend policy to the Student Council, relevant to the remit of the Zones, which may be related to education, student experience, and student activities.
2. Each Zone will be a space for the Students' Union to
 - (a) hear the views of students relating to students' experience of education, activities, and wellbeing and support; and,
 - (b) create suggestions for policy or recommendations for working groups to be submitted to Student Council, or any other relevant decision-making body.
3. Each Zone shall be supported and led by a Sabbatical Officer and are open to all students to attend.
4. The Students' Union shall publicise the Zone and support the Sabbatical Officer in leading it.
5. Relevant Students' Union and University staff members may be invited to the Zone to support, advise, and inform attendees of the matters under discussion.
6. Each Zone shall be held at least twice per academic year, one in Semester One and one in Semester Two, and additional Zones may be held, as necessary.
7. Each Zone shall be minuted, and the minutes of the Zone published on the Students' Union's website no later than 10 working days after the Zone is held and noted by Student Council at the Council's next meeting following the Zone.

Feedback

8. The Students' Union is committed to acting on feedback received from Zones.
9. The Students' Union will circulate updates, actions, and offer space for further feedback on matters raised at Zones.
